Information For Units:

SPONSORSHIP: Girls will be accepted for enrollment when sponsored directly by a unit of the American Legion Auxiliary or approved by a unit for sponsorship by another organization. Every unit of the American Legion Auxiliary in Georgia is urged to sponsor one or more citizens to Girls State. It is expected that most of the citizens will be sponsored by units. However, sponsorship of some citizens by civic, fraternal, and patriotic organizations is highly encouraged, provided the citizens are enrolled through a local unit. Any organization wishing to sponsor one or more citizens should contact the president or Girls State Chairman of the unit. Likewise, units are encouraged to contact community organizations most likely to sponsor a citizen. The fee shall not be paid by citizens, parents or any family member of a citizen. All organizations paying citizens' registration fees will be listed as sponsors, and they will receive recognition for full participation in the program. All citizens sponsored by organizations other than units will be selected in the same manner as those sponsored by Auxiliary units. Enrollment is limited. Therefore, Auxiliary units and other organizations desiring to sponsor citizens should make plans early to do so, sending fees at the earliest convenient date.

SELECTION OF GIRLS: A statement to be signed by the president of the sponsoring unit and high school principal, certifying that qualifications and requirements have been met, will be required for each girl selected. It is recommended that selection of girls be made in each case by a committee, consisting of the high school principal or counselor, unit president and the Girls State chairman, in addition to the head of any other organization sponsoring the citizens. Girls State is intended for the most outstanding girls, from the standpoint of leadership, character, and scholarship in the high schools. Only those girls who will enthusiastically devote their **FULL TIME** to increasing their knowledge, while at the same time advancing the whole Girls State Program, should be chosen.

REGISTRATION FEES: *The registration fee of \$195 is to be paid to the Director by April 10, 2007.* If a unit has not selected the girls it intends to send by April 10th, the registration fees for the number of girls to be sponsored may be sent, then the NAMES AND PICTURES of the girls may be sent by **May 21st**. This fee includes everything the girls will need while at Girls State, including meals, housing, manuals, medical attention, health and accident insurance. **IT DOES NOT INCLUDE SPENDING MONEY.**

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE: Citizens must report to Kennedy Hall on the campus of Georgia Southern University between 1:00 and 3:30 p.m. on Sunday, June 10 and they will depart on Friday, June 15 at 1:00 PM. Graduation is June 16, 2007 at 8:00 AM. Guests are invited. **Units sponsoring the citizens must be responsible for providing transportation, and definite arrangements for the trip from Statesboro to the hometown of the citizens are made well in advance of the departure date, with each citizen, of course being notified. NO LUNCH** will be provided on **Sunday**; citizens should make arrangements with their families or the persons bringing them to Georgia Southern. **Once the citizen has registered, they are not allowed to leave to go eat lunch. Make sure you have eaten before arriving on campus.**

Complete instructions on rules and regulations, general information, what to bring from home and other facts which citizens should know before leaving home for Girls State **WILL BE SENT TO EACH CITIZEN AS SOON AS THE APPLICATION IS RECEIVED FROM THE SPONSORING UNIT. Do Not Delay in sending in their applications. The forms (especially the medical forms) must be filled out in a timely manner. Also, as the Girls may submit a bill, the bill has a deadline for submission to the Director.**

GIRLS STATE STORE: Girls State has a store. A citizen must purchase a \$5.00 Consumption card for use at the Girls State Canteen. The girls are allowed to shop at the store during free time. Please tell the girls about the store.
