A Bill

Be it enacted by the Senate and/or House of Representatives of the Georgia Girls State here assembled, that:

- 1. Millions of American children are suffering unnecessary
- 2. harm from the lack of adequate child development services,
- 3. particularly since many parents must undertake or continue
- 4. full or part time employment, training or education.
- 5. The Secretary of Health, Education, and Welfare is
- 6. authorized and directed to provide financial assistance
- 7. for child development programs.
- 8. The Secretary shall apportion the amount allotted
- 9. to each State among the localities within each state
- 10. on the basis of population.
- 11. It is essential that the planning an operation of child
- 12. development programs must be undertaken as a
- 13. partnership of parents, community, and local government.
- 14. As used in this bill, the term "child development
- 15. programs" means those programs which provide
- 16. the educational, nutritional, social, medical, and
- 17. physical services needed for children who have
- 18. not attained the age of 15; program means any
- 19. mechanism, which provides full or part-day or night
- 20. services conducted in child development facilities,
- 21. in schools, in neighborhood centers, or in homes.
