A Bill

Be it enacted by the Senate and/or House of Representatives of the Georgia Girls State here assembled, that:

1. Millions of American children are suffering unnecessary
2. harm from the lack of adequate child development services,
3. particularly since many parents must undertake or continue
4. full or part time employment, training or education.
  
5. The Secretary of Health, Education, and Welfare is
6. authorized and directed to provide financial assistance
7. for child development programs.
  
8. The Secretary shall apportion the amount allotted
9. to each State among the localities within each state
10. on the basis of population.
  
11. It is essential that the planning an operation of child
12. development programs must be undertaken as a
13. partnership of parents, community, and local government.
  
14. As used in this bill, the term "child development
15. programs" means those programs which provide
16. the educational, nutritional, social, medical, and
17. physical services needed for children who have
18. not attained the age of 15; program means any
19. mechanism, which provides full or part-day or night
20. services conducted in child development facilities,
21. in schools, in neighborhood centers, or in homes.
